Toyo Seikan and UACJ's Next-Generation Aluminum Beverage EcoEnd™ Can Lid Wins Three Awards at The Canmaker Cans of the Year Awards 2024

Toyo Seikan Co., Ltd. ("Toyo Seikan"; President: Masanori Honda), a consolidated subsidiary of Toyo Seikan Group Holdings, Ltd. (Tokyo 5901; President: Ichio Otsuka), in collaboration with UACJ Corporation ("UACJ"; Tokyo 5741; President: Shinji Tanaka), has developed the aluminum beverage can lid "EcoEndTM" that reduces greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by approximately 40% compared to current products. This innovative product has received three awards at The Canmaker magazine's Cans of the Year Awards 2024, including the Gold Award in the "Ends, Caps & Closures "category, the "Sustainability" category, and the "Delegates' Choice" category.

We will continue to contribute to the reduction of environmental impact and the realization of a sustainable society through the development and provision of products and services that make significant contributions to reducing burdens on the environment.

[Product Overview]

EcoEnd™ significantly reduces GHG emissions while also achieving the same functionality as traditional can lids. Whereas traditional can lids make heavy use of primary aluminum, the EcoEnd™ manufacturing process makes a large cut in GHG emissions by substantially increasing the proportion of recycled materials, such as used beverage cans, thus reducing the environmental impact of GHG emissions by approximately 40% compared to traditional can lids.
